I. Director's Report

#### Director's Report July 2023

• Welcome to Alex Nunez, our new Library Trustee. Alex was sworn in on Monday, July 3rd.

• We are currently interviewing for the following positions: Assistant Director and a Full Time Clerk-Typist for the Children's Building.

• Our newsletter will now be created in-house by Selina Ferragamo who's other degree is in graphic design. Her first newsletter will be the September/October edition.

• Ian continues to work with the interested Champions of the Library members. The most recent meeting was held on Monday, June 26th. They are currently working on framing an

MOU to present to the Library. They have a proposed Board but it has not been finalized as of yet. (Friends of Libraries are non-profit, charitable groups formed to support libraries in their communities. Support from the Friends groups may be financial and cultural. Groups are separate from the libraries they support and made up of volunteers.)

- A reminder that the Library will be open on Saturdays in July and August from 9:00am 1:00pm.
- The DVD Leasing program began on July 6th.

• I met with Leah Topek-Walker from StonyBrook University in regard to the social work intern program. We are all set with our next intern beginning in September. Cameryn Fried will begin on September 7th. There is a possibility that we may receive a second intern as well.

• Emily recently applied for the Think Money or Kids Program Kits Financial Literacy Grant through the American Library Association. Thinking Money for Kids, an initiative of the American Library Association (ALA) and the FINRA Investor Education Foundation, strives to teach children and their parents, caregivers and educators about financial topics — like saving, spending, sharing and budgeting — in a way that is both meaningful and fun. ALA and the FINRA Foundation invite public libraries to apply to receive a Thinking Money for Kids Program Kit, a collection of expertly vetted resources to help libraries offer financial education for children ages 3 to 12, both in the library and in children's homes. We are waiting for a determination.

• I had received an email from Ancestry.com Newspapers in regard to digitizing our Westbury Times newspapers. This would be a wonderful and FREE opportunity for us. They will pay for all the shipping charges, will create portal access for Library use and will give us all digitized information on a hard drive. I have asked Kathleen to act as the person in charge of this project.

- The NLS TechMobile has been scheduled to be at the August 1st National Night Out and at our Fall Festival on October 14th.
- In conjunction with the NICE Bus, the Library now has a promotional sign at the Rockland Street bus stop. The defaced sign has been replaced.

• The Library-wide Summer Reading Program, All Together Now, began on June 26th and will run until August 11th. Be sure to speak to your Librarian for more information. As of July 12th, we have the following patrons signed up: Adults: 90 with 179 raffle entries, Teens 29, Childrens 196.

• The Westbury Historical Society is looking to grow their membership. Please contact our Curator, Thom Hoffman if you are interested in becoming a member.

• The 2023 Nassau Library Tour runs from June 12 - August 12. Visit all 58 Nassau County Libraries to be entered to win a grand raffle basket. For more information visit <u>https://tour.nassaulibrary.org/</u> As of July 12th, we have had 644 visits to our Library.

• Programming has scheduled a few bus trips through the Fall. The current summer bus trips are: Take Me Out to the Ballgame on August 20th with the Brooklyn Cyclones vs the

Hudson Valley Renegades and a visit to the Statue of Liberty and Ellis Island on September 21st.

• Scott from OSI and Tom have completed setting up our firewall on June 12th. They are now working on completing setting up the staff accounts for the server. We will meet with NacTel next week to go over plans for the phone system. We are planning to change the phone system over to Verizon from Optimum.

- We are waiting for all of the equipment to be delivered for the media room upgrade.
- We met with the chosen company regarding the motorized blinds to receive an updated plan, sizing and color swatches. This project will be done on August 31.
- Panic buttons were installed throughout both buildings. Locations have been added to the Emergency Manual for all staff.
- We have applied for a LILRC Technology Assistance Grant in order to purchase chromebooks to begin our circulating technology program. We are currently waiting for a decision to be made.

• A grant request has been sent into the Bethpage Federal Bank Charitable Donation program for a garden beautification project for the Library's two front gardens. We are waiting to hear back.

- The sealcoating and striping for the parking lot were moved to Saturday, July 22 and Sunday, July 23rd due to weather.
